⁴ Both Wheaton in Quebec and semester programs in France (FREN 335 Francophone Civilization and Culture, FREN 338 Advanced French in Francophone Country, plus other coursework to equal 12-15 semester hours) fulfill the study abroad requirement for the major: most students choose either the semester in France or the summer program in Quebec, but some decide to do both programs.

⁵ French 347 Francophone Literature is offered odd years in Fall only and has been approved as HNGR elective
