<sup>2</sup> Required to graduate. Academic term in China or approved summer study abroad program. One term of study in a Chinese-speaking country. Wheaton in China (CHIN 334 on or off campus, pre-requisite for summer Wheaton in China program and CHIN 338 or 341 off campus) may be used to fulfill the requirement for a term of study abroad. Students can also complete an equivalent semester abroad program (at least 6 hours of which must be taken in Chinese) with an accredited academic institution in China if approved by the department and College. Credits earned during a semester of study abroad may be applied either to a second major (with approval of that major department), to the Chinese major, or (upon approval) to both.

<sup>3</sup> It is recommended to complete CHIN 303 before CHIN 332.

<sup>4</sup> The Chinese major requires 12 hours of elective credits. Please note CHIN 301 Character Acquisition<sup>\*\*</sup> (2 credit) and CHIN 335 Business Chinese<sup>\*\*</sup> (2 credit) are offered every other year and CHIN 351 Classical Chinese Poetry<sup>\*\*</sup> (2 credit) is offered by request.
