TUITION AND FEE PAYMENT

All Spring 2026 semester charges are to be paid by Monday, January 12, 2026. If a balance remains after January 12, a \$75.00 late payment will be charged. In addition, a 1.5% per month late charge on the average balance will be assessed to all unpaid student accounts unless on the Wheaton Installment Program.

COURSE ADDS & DROPS

Students desiring to add and/or drop courses must do so on Banner Self Service by the appropriate deadlines (see above). Excluding pre-term courses, a drop in total hours which impacts tuition charges will result in a full refund through January 23, 2026, with no refund thereafter.

WITHDRAWAL FROM COLLEGE

Any student finding it necessary to withdraw from the College while currently enrolled in class must complete and submit the Withdraw or Cancel Enrollment form and meet with the Dean of Student Wellness in the Student Development office. **A student who does not officially withdraw with the required approvals receives no refund.** Consult the College Catalog for withdrawal refund policies.

U.S. VOTER REGISTRATION

The Higher Education Act of 1998 requires colleges and universities to make a good faith effort to make voter registration forms available to you. A limited number of voter registration forms for the State of Illinois are available to students at Wheaton College during business hours on campus. INSTRUCTIONS FOR ADVANCE REGISTRATION FOR SPRING 2026

The preferred method of registration is via Banner Student Service. **You may initiate web registration at the time posted in your Registration Dashboard (see web registration instructions below).**

All degree-seeking graduate and undergraduate students who plan to continue in the spring at Wheaton College should initiate advance registration by November 21, 2025. **Failure to do so may result in a cancellation of your housing assignment and may require an application for late registration and result in a \$75 late registration fee.**

Students applying for off-campus study for spring should complete the GoGlobal process and submit their registration statement to the Registrar's Office by November 21, 2025.

Please complete the following:

1. Make an appointment with your faculty advisor for advising. *First-year and Transfer students* should refer to instructions from the Academic Advising Office.
2. Complete preliminary planning prior to your advisor meeting.
 - a. Check the Catalog (catalog.wheaton.edu) for course descriptions, pre-requisites, and general requirements.
 - b. Check Degree Works for outstanding requirements. The Degree Works dashboard is available under the Banner: Student Services widget in the [Wheaton Gateway](#).
3. Have your **faculty advisor** provide you with your **ALTERNATE (Registration) PIN**.

DIRECTIONS FOR WEB REGISTRATION

1. Login to the Wheaton Gateway. Your login/password should be your network username and password. If you have difficulty accessing your account, please contact Academic & Institutional Technology (AIT) at ait.service.desk@wheaton.edu or 630.752.4357.
2. Under the Banner: Student Services widget, select the **Registration Dashboard**.
3. Select **ADD AND DROP CLASSES**.
 - If you have not yet signed the Community Covenant and Statement of Financial Responsibility (and Statement of Faith if you're a Graduate School student) **this term**, you will be prompted to do so before you can register.
4. Select the **SPRING 2026 TERM** and submit.
5. When prompted, input the **ALTERNATE (Registration) PIN** you received from your faculty advisor.
6. Input the CRN's of the courses you wish to register for in the appropriate boxes and submit.
7. If a class is closed, certain classes will allow you to join the waitlist for the class. **Select the waitlist option from the drop-down box and submit.** The instructor will need to contact the Registrar's Office for any overrides or exceptions for course registration.

AUDIT POLICY

Undergraduate:

Any student may audit up to two courses a semester by filing an approved audit application to the Registrar's Office by the add/drop deadline for the course. A \$50 audit fee is charged per course. An audit does not meet any Wheaton requirements. No credit is given for courses audited. To have the audit recorded on a student's transcript, the student is required to complete certain course requirements. In addition to the audit fee, any course fees will also be charged. Private lessons and independent studies cannot be audited.

Graduate School

Any student carrying a full-time academic schedule (8 or more semester hours) may audit one course without charge by filing an approved audit application at the Registrar's Office. In addition, part-time graduate students who will complete *all* graduation requirements by the end of the current semester are entitled to a free audit. No credit is given for courses audited. To have the audit recorded on a student's transcript, the student is required to complete certain course requirements. In addition to the audit fee, any course fees will also be charged. Part-time graduate students auditing courses are charged the student audit rate.

Spouse Audits: The audit privilege for a full-time graduate student may be used by the student's spouse if the student is not auditing a course. Application for a spouse audit is made through the Graduate Admissions Office.

Experimental Courses: Spring 2026

EXPERIMENTAL COURSES (on the schedule, but not in the catalog)

BIOL 340: Tropical Marine and Rainforest Ecology (2 cr.) CRN 13839.

This course introduces students to the most biodiverse ecosystems on Earth, the nearshore tropical marine environment and the tropical rainforest. Characterized by complex interrelationships between flora and fauna, these systems are some of the most biologically exciting, and yet also in greatest peril. Students are introduced to the key concepts in tropical ecology and develop knowledge and skills needed to effectively navigate these systems in future field work. This course is designed to be a prerequisite for, and in conjunction with BIOL 350 Tropical Marine and Rainforest Ecology in Belize.
\$50 Course Fee.

COMM 330: Leadership and Communication (4 cr.) CRN 13841.

Welcome to Leadership and Communication. This comprehensive course explores the intersection of leadership theory and effective communication practices. The course is divided into two major components: first, we will examine foundational and contemporary leadership theories, exploring various leadership styles, approaches, and contexts. Second, we will focus on the practical application of leadership communication skills in real-world scenarios. This is an experiential course that integrates theoretical understanding with hands-on practice. Topics include transformational leadership, authentic leadership, cross-cultural communication, crisis communication, ethical leadership communication, and leading through change.

PSYC 300: Asian American Psychology (4 cr.) CRN 13828.

Course approaches the diversity of Asian American experience through a psycho-social-spiritual lens. Concepts of culture, ethnicity, and race applied to individual, familial, community, and societal levels form the foundation of our learning and analysis. Although Asian Americans in the US are often racialized as being monolithic, we will strive to hold the tension between shared experiences with the immense diversity that falls under the AA umbrella. Holding that education is personally and socially transformative, this course seeks to promote well-being and mental health for AA individuals and communities within our own systems.
